

# TO **VOTE** IN NEBRASKA

- ✓ You must be a United States citizen.
- ✓ You must be 18 years of age or older on General Election Day.
- ✓ You must be a resident of Nebraska.

## VOTING ACCOMMODATIONS

All polling places in Nebraska must be accessible to voters with disabilities.

## HOW TO REGISTER



### Register Online

To register to vote online, visit:

### Register by Mail or In Person

Request a Voter Registration form through your local County Clerk's office.

## MAKE SURE YOUR VOICE IS HEARD

Lawmakers pay attention to people who vote in their districts.

- ➔ Nobody can tell you how to vote.
- ➔ Vote for issues you care about.
- ➔ Vote for candidates who support issues that matter to you.

### ✓ There isn't a voting "test."

You don't have to take any tests to register to vote in Nebraska.

### ✓ You can ask for help.

You can vote by yourself or with help from a friend, family member, or polling place worker.

### ✓ Voting is free.

It does not cost anything to vote or to register to vote.

### ✓ Vote by mail or in person.

You can complete your ballot at home and mail it in OR go to your polling place to vote.

### ✓ If you have been convicted of a felony...

You can register to vote if it's been 2 or more years since you've finished your sentence, including parole.

### ✓ If you have a Guardian...

People with a Guardian, Payee, or Conservator can still vote unless a judge has specifically taken that right away.

### ✓ If you live in a facility...

People who live in group homes and facilities have a right to vote!
