- You can vote by yourself, or with help from a friend, family member, or even one of the people working at the place where you go to vote.
- You have the right to vote by mail or in person. It's your choice.
- You have the right to vote even if you live in a group home or facility.
- Even if you have a Guardian, Payee, or Conservator, you have the right to vote unless a judge has specifically taken that right away.
- You will need to show photo ID to vote. You can get a free State ID card.
- You have the right to vote however you want. This means that nobody is allowed to tell you who of what to vote for or against. It's your choice.
- Even if you have a felony conviction, you can register to vote as soon as your sentence or parole is done.
